## Race Rules

The USA Cycling rule book aims to provide consistent competition guidelines and ensure safety and fair play across all cycling events. [Rulebook Download](#)

### USA Cycling Rules & Policies

1. Momentum Indy is held under USA Cycling permit #8694.
2. Momentum Indy includes races that are USA Cycling sanctioned and regulated; as such, Momentum Indy is required to follow the rules and regulations set forth by USA Cycling. We follow all rules and regulations on racer eligibility and classification are set forth by USA Cycling.
3. Free-lap rule is in effect. Lapped riders may be pulled at the official's discretion.
4. Riders must present a valid 2024 USA Cycling license at registration to enter any race. Novice One-day Race licenses (men, women, or juniors) may be purchased for \$15 upon registering online or onsite. Any former member with a racing category excluded by the Novice One-day Race license is eligible to purchase an Experienced One-day Race license for \$35 once per year.
5. Race promoter reserves the right to shorten, modify, cancel or combine any race or prize list in the event of insufficient entries, acts of God, fire, flood, natural disaster, war or threat of war, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disorder, unauthorized strikes, governmental regulation or advisory, recognized health threats as determined by the World Health Organization, the Centers for Disease Control, or local government authority or health agencies (including but not limited to the health threats of COVID-19, H1N1, or similar infectious diseases).
6. Masters Cat 1-4 (40/50/60+) and Masters Cat 4/5 (40/50/60+) shall be scored separately. Purse to be paid to top three finishers in each age group.
7. Pre-registration closes on Wednesday at 11:59pm EST the week of the event.
8. Onsite Registration will open 2 hours prior to the start of the first race and close 30 minutes before the start of each race. No discounts will be offered for registering for a second race. **Please note: Walk-up registration is CREDIT CARD ONLY. No Cash, No Checks.**
9. Results are final after the standard 15-minute protest period for each race. All results will be final after the protest period has ended.
10. Helmets required.
11. Online pre-registration is strongly encouraged. NO REFUNDS. If COVID 19 conditions or events beyond the event promoters control force a cancellation of the 2023 event, all entry will be transferred to the 2024 edition.



## Organizational Information

### Organization

Momentum Indy is a two-day bicycle festival and omnium race serving as the 9<sup>th</sup> stop of the America's Criterium Cup, held under USAC permit # 8694. All 2024 USAC rules apply. The UCI scale of penalties applies to the Men's Pro 1/2 and Women's Pro 1/2 events.

### American Criterium Cup Points

The Mass Ave Crit Men's Pro 1/2 and the Women's Pro 1/2 races are part of the American Criterium Cup. Racers will accrue points according to the ACC Points Schedule (located [here](#)). These points are used for American Criterium Cup rankings; they are separate from Momentum Indy Omnium scoring.

### Eligibility

1. Teams are limited to 6 riders for the Mass Ave Crit only.
2. Participation in the American Criterium Cup is limited to men's and women's UCI teams and USA Cycling registered Domestic Elite Teams or individuals of Cat 1/2 (men) or Cat 1/2 (women) or their equivalent of a foreign license holder.
3. Men's and Women's Elite is open to all ages, excluding juniors (U23 racers points will count towards both competitions). Men must be on a UCI registered team or hold a category 1 or 2 license (or foreign equivalent). Women must be on a UCI registered team or hold a category 1 or 2 license (or foreign equivalent).
4. Men's and Women's U23 is open to racers that will not turn 23 until after December 31, 2024. U23 racer's points will count towards both the Elite and U23 category. U23 racers will have their points counted towards team totals like any other racer.

## General Regulations

### Packet Pickup

1. Race day packet pickup will be at registration for each race venue. Registration is available up to 30-minutes prior to the start of each event.
2. Race numbers are not transferable.
3. A valid racing license must be shown at packet pick-up or for any onsite registration.
4. You may only race in the category for which you have a license or in the appropriate age category.
5. Your appropriate age category is the age you will be as of December 31, 2024.
6. At the time of packet pickup, all registered riders will be required to complete and sign the USA Cycling Accident Waiver and Release of Liability if not previously completed through the online waiver.
7. Riders under the age of 18 will also require the signature of a parent or legal guardian.
8. No refunds will be given.
9. One (1) race number will be issued. Bib number must be placed on the **LEFT SIDE** of the back of the jersey with the bottom edge of the bib number aligned with the jersey side seam. (#'s will run vertically on the back.) No folding or trimming of #'s is allowed.

### Bib Numbers

1. Each race packet will contain one race number. Numbers may not be folded or trimmed. You will receive a second race number if you are racing in more than one race category.
2. Number must be worn on the **LEFT SIDE** for all events and the bottom should be aligned with the side seam of the jersey (vertical orientation).
3. If you lose your number, you will be charged a \$10 fee for a replacement number.



## Omnium Races

1. Omnium: Men Pro 1/2 race: \$2,500 overall-15 places (pts based); Women Pro 1/2 race: \$2,500 overall-15 places (pts based).
2. Points: 25, 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.
3. Riders are required to register for all races in order to qualify for the Omnium.
4. Scoring of Ties: In case of a tie on total points, the tie will be broken in favor of the rider who has:
  - a) The most first place finishes,
  - b) If still tied, the most second place finishes, etc.,
  - c) If still tied, the highest placing in the last race, or the race nearest the last race of the omnium in which at least one of the tied riders placed.

## Finish, Prizes, Primes

After completing your race, please do not congregate at the finish line. Never cross the finish line in the opposite direction or a second time in the same direction. Be aware of the finish line cameras!

1. Results will NOT be physically posted on-site.
2. Results will be available online:

3. RACER MUST SHOW RACE NUMBER AND RACE LICENSE TO CLAIM PRIZES AND PRIMES.
4. Only the racer himself/herself can claim prizes. Racer must provide a legible signature when claiming a prize.



## Payout Procedures

1. All cash prizes will be sent via PayPal within 7-10 business days following the event. If payment is being made to a business, the standard PayPal merchant fee of 2.99% will be charged to the transaction. Payments to individuals do not incur a fee from PayPal.
2. When racers collect bib at Registration, please verify NAME, EMAIL, and PHONE.
3. Physical checks will not be mailed.
4. Individuals with combined winnings of \$600 or more (including cash prizes) will be required to complete an [IRS form W-9](#) prior to being issued their prize money. It is the racers' responsibility to complete the W-9 and send it to: [info@momentumindy.org](mailto:info@momentumindy.org) or pick up a paper copy at Registration.
5. All prize winnings will be issued to racers, not race teams. NO EXCEPTIONS.
6. Please verify results within the standard 15-minute protest period for each race. All results will be final after the protest period has ended.

1. All Racers must stay in the designated starting corral before the start of their race.
2. All racers are responsible for knowing the course and following USA Cycling rules.
3. Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protests and appeals.

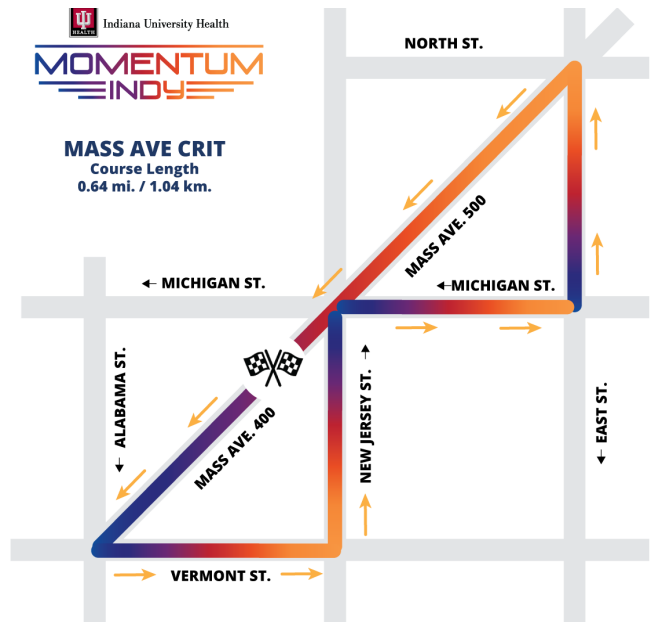


## Criterion Details

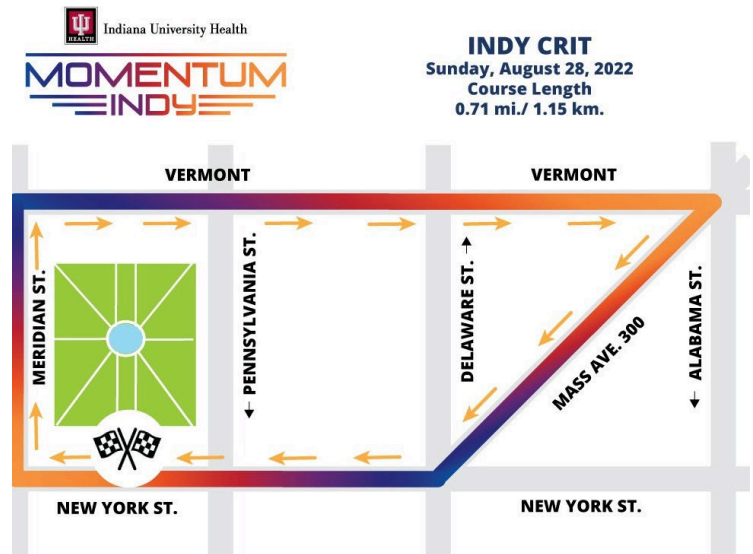

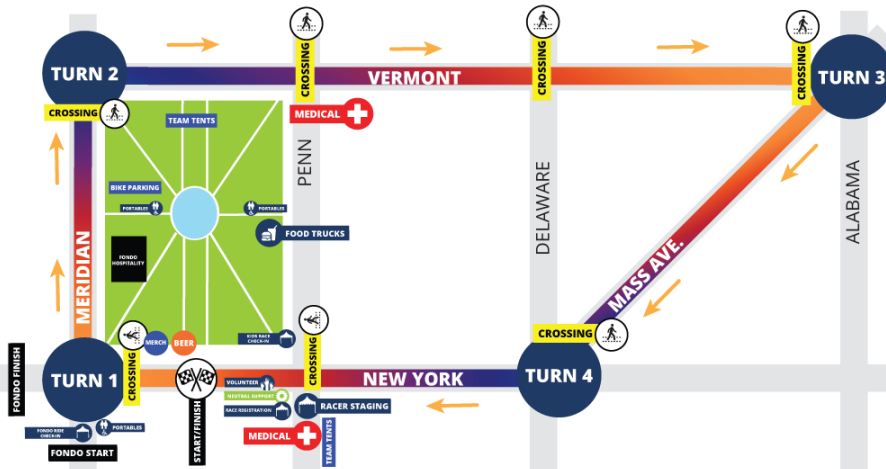


## Venue Maps
